There is a huge amount planned in 2025 as we celebrate 40 years since we welcomed our first patient to the Hospice, way back in September 1985. So much has happened since then, and 2025 is busier than ever with some fantastic events and activities to get involved with.

Right at the forefront is **Stomp Round Leicester**. From July to September this free, fun, family friendly art trail will see **40 giant Elephant sculptures** hidden around the city forming a trail of discovery for all to enjoy.
