THINKING AHEAD: EXPLORING AND UNDERSTANDING

EXPERIENCES AND DECISIONS IN END OF LIFE CARE

Are you from an ethnic background and would you be willing to share your thoughts and experiences of caring for a relative or close friend who has died from a serious illness in the last 3 to 12 months?

Our aim is to find out about the experiences of people from ethnic backgrounds living with serious illness. We would like to speak to a family or friend carer and a doctor or nurse who supported the patient towards the end of their life. The information we collect will help us improve the training that doctors and nurses have and the care they provide for patients and their families.

Participating in this study will involve a one to one interview with a member of the research team. The interview can take place in your home, at LOROS Hospice or another location of your choice and arranged at your convenience. This will be an informal discussion, usually lasting up to an hour.
