# Tricia Stewart

## The Original WI Calendar Girl

As guest speaker on the day we are delighted to welcome Tricia Stewart, the originator and driving force behind one of the world's most famous fundraisers ever.

Tricia created the Alternative WI Calendar and was subsequently portrayed by Dame Helen Mirren in the film Calendar Girls. She has a truly amazing and inspirational story to tell.

Tricia first joined the WI in 1983 after being invited by her neighbour, Angela, and was a member for fifteen years before Angela's husband, John, was diagnosed with non-Hodgkin's lymphoma. Tricia thought it would be amusing to do an Alternative WI Calendar featuring the crafts of WI, but the girls would be nude. John knew about the plans but never believed they would do it. Touched by John's death later that year, Tricia created the calendar in memory of John and to raise funds for leukaemia research.

In April 1999, a calendar featuring 11 women aged 45 to 65 gained extensive media coverage, making headlines in national newspapers for three weeks. It sold 88,000 copies that year, inspiring thousands and changing the image of the WI and perception of older women.

The success was followed by the movie 'Calendar Girls' based on the story of the Alternative WI Calendar, Tricia's book 'Calendar Girl', numerous theatre performances and a musical. With an initial aim to raise £5,000 for the Leukemia Research Foundation, the story has raised over £4 million.
