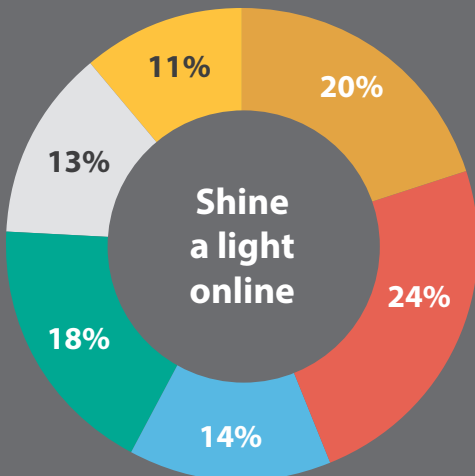
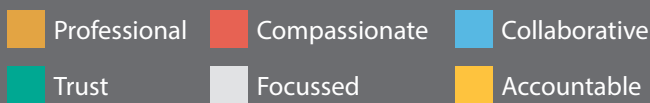
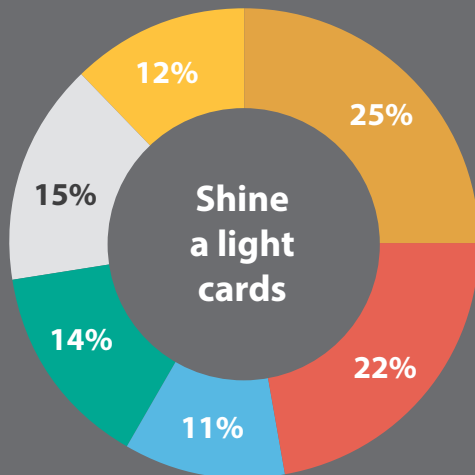


# 86 Shine a light cards
