

Terms and conditions for LOROS Tree of Life local hero awards

- The 'LOROS Tree of Life local hero' award programme is a unique event which runs from Monday 12th February until 11.50pm on Friday 22nd March 2024.
- Entries must be under one of four categories: Inspirational young person (18 years or under), outstanding group, good neighbour, dedicated carer. Entries must be made via the online form, paper form or email.
- LOROS Hospice is a local charity, serving the communities of Leicester, Leicestershire and Rutland, therefore nominees and nominators should be living or working within those areas.
- The awards arise from a donation made in memory of Kate Newman. Nominations will be assessed by a judging panel consisting of LOROS staff and friends and family of Kate Newman. The judging panel's decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
- Winners will be notified no later than mid May 2024.
- For nominations of persons aged 13 years and under, we will require the authority of their parent/guardian. LOROS will contact relevant parties to obtain this.
- The 'award' is a leaf on the LOROS Tree of Life, engraved with the winning nomination's name and category of nomination. There is no different prize or cash alternative.
- LOROS reserves the right to change the number of awards available in each category.
- Winners will need to agree to have their awards publicised, and speak to media if required.
- LOROS will use gathered data only in accordance with its privacy policy, [which can be viewed here](#).
- You cannot nominate yourself for an award – all nominations must come from a third party.
